Lenten Regulations for the Diocese of Lincoln

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast **and** abstinence. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence. **Fasting** means eating only one full meal with two smaller meals, which together do not equal the full meal. No snacks or eating between meals allowed. Fasting obliges all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. **Abstinence** means eating no meat, and no soup or gravy

made from meat. Abstinence obliges all Catholics age 14 and over.

Sickness, hard manual labor, pregnancy, etc. excuse a person from these obligations. Nevertheless, it should be pointed out that these are <u>serious</u> obligations. In cases of doubt or question, the priest who hears a person's confession should be consulted.
