
Notes from Father Walsh...

Vacation. Looking forward to my vacation in Colorado with Frs. Morin, Brethour, and Tucker. We're leaving Wednesday after Mass (July 17) and I'll return July 24.So, I miss the Totus Tuus program, but have recruited Fr. Major to help with confessions and daily Mass. Daily Mass will be 11:30, Monday thru Friday, and 6:30, Wednesday. All are welcome to attend the 11:30 Mass and share in the prayer with the children. The Missionary Coop priest will be coming to the parish on Sunday, July 21 to offer Mass with us and make his appeal for the missions.

Parish Finance Council. The parish Finance Council met on July 8. Three members were present with Father Walsh: Jerry Lentfer, Melissa Wallman and Denise Clements. Not present was Jenny Oelke, whose work required an overnight in Grand Island, but who has generously accepted the role of chair for the Council. The group discussed the financial guidelines for internal and physical control of the money of the parish as well as the annual financial review. Fr. Walsh presented an unaudited P/L Statement as well as an unaudited Balance Sheet which served to orient the members on the financial activities and position of the parish. A rough draft of the 2019-2020 budget was also presented. Annually, the Diocese requires several reports on parish financial activities. The Council will monitor this process.

Maintenance Issues. During the week, an exterminator sprayed the church and rectory, I signed the service agreement with the Action Plumbing, Heating and Air Conditioning for a biannual inspection of our HVAC units (they will be here late July to conduct the first of those two inspections) and a locksmith came and helped establish a key control system for parish keys. Jarod Fortner fixed the gutter/interior wall/siding problem on the north side of the church, and Pat Milke arranged for a load and a half of gravel to be dropped on our parking lot and someone to come and spread it out. It was a good week for the care of the parish!
