Notes from Father Walsh...

I am on retreat this week, beginning Sunday and ending Thursday. Please remember me in your prayers. Thank you.

Do you remember your wedding day, and the questions the priest asked you prior to the exchange of consent? One of the questions dealt with the acceptance of children, and the promise to raise them in the Catholic faith. This is the current formulation of that question: *Are you prepared to accept children lovingly from God and to bring them up according to the law of Christ and his Church?* Answering yes to this question confirmed the couple's acceptance of the grave obligation to be open to life and form and educate their offspring in the faith. The Church assists in this work, through Catholic schools and parish CCD programs. Parents can also homeschool their children in the faith. Neglecting this responsibility is a grave sin, imperiling not only the eternal salvation of parents but their children as well. It's serious business! Children too have an obligation to grow in their faith, and as they grow older, the obligation begins to shift more onto their shoulders. A high school student who refuses to attend CCD, for example, is responsible for neglecting his or her faith, and fails in the observance of the first and most important commandment of the Decalogue: I am the Lord your God; you shall have no strange gods before me.

I pray we have a great CCD year, starting August 25, 2019 and continuing through May 3, 2020. According to our parish statistics, we have 95 children in kindergarten through 8th grade, and 43 high school students. The Lord is eager to share His love and life with our young people. Let's help Him by supporting the CCD program, ensuring attendance of the children, and by our prayerful participation each Sunday at Mass.
