The meeting was opened with prayer. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

**Old Business:** Rosie VerMaas gave an update on the church directory. Jenny Oelke volunteered to set up a computer program for parishioners to use to sign up for time slots for having their family pictures taken. Lizzie Milke will begin taking pictures on Wednesdays and Saturdays starting August 21st. The church directories will cost the families \$15.00 each and they will have the option to purchase pictures.
