We've launched the Faith Direct electronic giving program for the parish, and presently have three people enrolled. I anticipate, by the end of the week, that the number will increase significantly, but we've launched, and I am very happy.

Google **stjamescortland.com** in your search engine and our website will come up. On the top of the home page, you will see the decal for Faith Direct. Click on that and go exploring!

I enrolled on Wednesday (the second enrollee) and it was simple. I especially liked the opportunity for the many extra gifts that can be given during the year, things like KC and Altar Society dues, Peter's Pence, the Register, and the building and improvement fund. Every special collection is listed, along with the Holy Days. I chose the first draw down of the month, and the option to give once a month versus weekly. It is very simple. And I can go back into the site and change any of these things, add more, select a gift from my credit card versus my checking account, etc. The tool is easy to use, under my control and solidly secure.


When I was in Hastings, I was surprised by the number of people older than me who chose to use this technology. Perhaps I am out of touch with what is going on in family life (evidently true!) but I thought electronic giving was a natural for our younger crowd and somewhat over the top for the older folks. I was wrong. Finding envelopes is probably harder than trusting that your account is secure. I can attest that this company is the best in security, and during the 8 years I used it in Hastings, we had excellent customer service.

Once we've signed up for Faith Direct, the parish will cancel our envelopes. I like that too. It saves about \$7 a family. So, we've already saved \$21 with this program. Okay—we haven't saved much since Faith Direct does cost us a bit. I estimate this program will cost us about \$1,200 a year, or about the same cost we are expending for envelopes. The upside is there is far less waste. Good stuff. Give it a try! God bless you.
