## Notes from Father Walsh -

tithing. We now have 24 families using electronic giving, just over 15% of our parish. Normally, parishes that begin this program hit about 20% enrollment in the first year. I'm hoping for a little better number, mostly because I'm a type A personality! I also know what a great tool this is, how it helps me manage my tithing and helps the parish sustain its offertory goals. It puts discipline, predictability, and commitment behind my need to tithe. Don't know about you, but I looked closely at the various contribution reports sent to me this past month from the chancery, St. Cecilia and St. James. I had a good giving year, and it pleased me. I bet you had a reaction too. Nearly all of my contributions were given electronically. It's part of the reason why I was able to be successful in my giving. What would you like for Lent? Presently, our Lenten devotionals include adding Stations of the Cross on Friday nights at 7pm and promoting our exposed Eucharistic Adoration program on Thursday nights. The practice of daily Mass, which is early in our parish (6:30am), is also a great spiritual undertaking with rich spiritual benefits. We would like to propose an educational opportunity to the parish, perhaps a Bible study or a doctrinal study. Ginger Jelinek has offered to oversee this effort. Would you like the presentation one half hour before Mass on Sunday, or perhaps on Thursday night, before the 7pm Eucharistic holy hour? I have a great 6 part series on the Mass from Bishop Baron. I showed it 30 minutes before Sunday Masses in Hastings a few years ago. It was well received. If you are interested in a particular educational effort in the parish this Lent, speak to me or Ginger.
