Notes from Father Walsh -

Knights of Columbus. Our monthly Knights of Columbus meeting was held this past Wednesday, and part of the agenda included a report on the One Rose, One Life campaign. You may remember that we had a special collection for this campaign in January. Nearly \$1,000 was collected from the parish for this cause. The gift of our parish was rounded up by the Knights to \$1,000 and this money was sent to the State Knights of Columbus to support the state-wide pro-life efforts of the Knights. But that was just the beginning. Our Knights Council has had the practice of matching this collection from the congregation, and so another \$1,000 was allocated and this money will go to support a new initiative beginning in Lincoln, the Women's Care Center which will be located across the street from Planned Parenthood, and offer free counseling, free ultrasound, free maternal care items for women considering abortion. I'm proud of our Knights. This is what a Catholic charitable organization does.
