Notes from Father Walsh -


Spiritual Exam. Okay, it's time for our first spiritual exam of Lent, 2020. We're into this journey 10 days. Let's take stock. Have I increased my prayer? Have I renounced the sin in my life and begun to take steps toward conversion? Am I listening to the Word of God and allowing Him to form my life anew? This past Wednesday, the gospel for our Mass included these words:

"This generation is an evil generation; it seeks a sign, but no sign will be given it, except the sign of Jonah. Just as Jonah became a sign to the Ninevites, so will the Son of Man be to this generation."

Among the messages of these words is the clear directive of the Lord. He expects us to take seriously the gift of Lent He has given us. 'Keep your eyes fixed on me,' He seems to say. 'Ponder what I did—the gift of my life for others—and imitate what you see. I'm not going to force you to change. I'm not going to stop the world if you don't. You have to choose. And you'll perish if you don't.'

Okay. We hear His word. We need to keep hearing it, allowing it to form us, allowing Him to lead us. If Lent hasn't been going well, remember this maxim of the spiritual life: begin again. That sums up how we make progress. As long as we're here in this world, we're always beginning again. And we'll do it again and again until we are formed anew by the finishing hand of God in the life to come. God bless you.
