This doctrine was promulgated by the Church at the request of thousands and thousands of bishops, priests, religious and laity of the Catholic world. They loved Mary, and everyone believed that she was assumed body and soul into heaven at the end of her earthly life. The Catholic world desired to honor her by making this belief a matter of doctrinal faith. The Assumption of our Most Blessed Mother was formally defined by Pope Pius XII on November 1, 1950 in his Apostolic Constitution Munificentissimus Deus. Thanks be to God!
