Notes from Father Walsh...

St James Parish Council and Parish Finance Council met August 12, 2020 in a combined group. Those in attendance were Father Joseph Walsh, Ray Vrbka, Pat Milke, Rosie VerMaas, Shirley Yates, Jenny Oelke, Denise Clements, Melissa Wallman, and Grace Benes.

The meeting was opened with prayer. The January minutes were read.

Finance Council: Jenny Oelke handed out the Balance Sheet as of June 30, 2020, the Profit and Loss Statement for the year July 2019 through June 2020 and the 2019 -2020 Budget Worksheet. Jenny and Father Walsh discussed these items with the group. Father Walsh also passed out information on Faith Direct giving at St James. There are currently 47 families using Faith Direct to give to St James. The monthly donations through Faith Direct amount to around \$6,000 or nearly 50% of our adult envelope tithe.

After a review of the budget for the 2020- 2021 fiscal year, Jenny Oelke made a motion to approve the budget and Melissa Wallman seconded the motion. The motion was passed by unanimous vote of both Councils.

Old Business:

Property Report: Pat Milke discussed the insurance estimates for replacing the roofs on the church and rectory due to hail damage from a storm that went through Cortland. He will contact White Castle Roofing for an estimate. We will have the siding that needs replaced fixed at the same time as the roof.

Ray Vrbka has talked to Wes Meints regarding an estimate for replacement of the link door. The door will be replaced this fall.

New Business:

Father Walsh introduced Shirley Yates as our new CCD coordinator. The plan is to start CCD on Sunday, September 13, 2020. The 10:00 AM Sunday Mass will be moved back to 10:30 to accommodate CCD class time. There have been volunteers to teach the 2nd, 3rd and high school classes. Registration will be Sunday, August 30th.

Kurt Larkins has volunteered use of a building in Cortland to be used for the high school class. Pat said the building has heat and air conditioning, but we will have to furnish it with a rug and things to sit on.

Father Walsh suggested purchasing a laptop and projector for use by the CCD teachers. The Diocesan Education Department has a large volume of excellent resource material for CCD classes. It was recommended that we go with flat screen televisions instead of projectors. Father will arrange for two laptops and televisions for the grade school and one set for the high school.

The Knights of Columbus would like to sponsor a parish picnic. The tentative date is set for September 26th. Father Walsh then asked us to think of ideas to reengage the parish in Mass attendance. The hope is that with CCD starting, Mass attendance will pick up.

The meeting was adjourned with prayer.
