Notes from Father Walsh...

My apologies... for being absent last weekend and again this weekend. I am doing Vicar for Clergy work with a priest and his community that needs my assistance. My plan is to be back in the pulpit next weekend. Thank you for your patience with me, and your accommodating support.

Teacher's Meeting: the teaching staff for CCD met this past Wednesday, and we have planned the coming CCD year. We have excellent, committed, excited teachers, waiting for your children to come and join them on their journey to know, love and serve the Lord. I think it is going to be a great year.

CCD Items:

1. We're following the local public school policy for COVID prevention. Because social distancing will be nearly impossible, I am asking all children and teachers to wear masks during CCD. Children under three should not wear masks.
2. The cost of CCD is \$15 per student.
3. Classes begin on Sunday, September 13, at 9:05am.
4. During the second week of classes, all students will be oriented on the Diocese of Lincoln Safe and Sacred protocol.
5. We've purchased and acquired a variety of technological resources for the CCD program this year, including lap top computers, projectors and television sets. We've upgraded the Wi-Fi in the hall and hope to have enough power in the system to manage the use by the teachers. The Diocese has excellent teaching materials available on the Religious Education site of the Diocese's website. Take a look at what your children are learning, and share in their discoveries and faith journey!

Formed.org. The parish has purchased a subscription to formed.org, a web platform that has spectacular Catholic resources. (There was some technical difficulty with this program in the past. I called the company this week, and the problem was resolved.) There are books, movies, educational programs, and special talks. Check it out. Google formed.org and chose the tab "I belong to a parish or organization." This will take you to a page where you will be asked the name of your parish. Type in 68331 or St. James, Cortland Nebraska. Then, you will be asked to provide a name and an email address. Once this is done, you will be asked to check your email box, and upon opening the email and clicking on the decal to gain access, you will be taken to the formed.org platform. You are now registered, and can access all of these resources free of cost. Next time you google formed.org you simply need to sign in. It's easy. Enjoy!
