**CCD Report.** We had 96 children in Kindergarten through 8th grade attend CCD last Sunday, and 16 high schoolers. We accommodated the grade school space needs, though the 7th and 8th grade class is large and nice weather offered an opportunity for the kids to go outside, which helped. The high school space is tight. Okay, it's real tight. We will see how things progress with the high schoolers in the next few weeks, and see if the space will continue to serve our needs. The kids and teachers managed the COVID challenge, with masks and hand sanitizers. Everything seemed to go well in that arena. Thank you all for cooperating with this directive. It's keeping us open!

**Bishop's Appeal for Vocations.** As we have done the past several years, the Bishop conducts a fall campaign to support the cost of educating our seminarians and running the vocations office of the Diocese. The annual Vocations Office budget is \$1.3 million, of which \$1.175 million goes directly to the educational expenses of the seminarians. I will offer the appeal homily next weekend. Those who have supported the appeal in the past as well as other appeals from the Bishop's office will receive their commitment card in the mail this week. All other cards will be available in the back of the church for easy access following next weekend's Masses. I plan to have the cards available in the annex for a couple of weeks. Our parish goal for the appeal is \$5,190—a very doable number. Last year, our parish donated \$8,098 to this appeal. Thank you!
