

Here are some of the concerns of this program that the Nebraska Catholic Conference wants to bring to our attention:

- In 1st Grade, students "define gender, gender identity, and gender-role stereotypes."
- In 4th Grade, students "distinguish between sex assigned at birth and gender identity and explain how they may or may not differ."
- In 5th Grade, students "explain that gender expression and gender identity exist along a spectrum."
- In 6th Grade, students "define and explain differences between cisgender, transgender, gender non-binary, gender expansive, and gender identity.
