The Nebraska Catholic Conference (the Bishops of Nebraska public policy arm) has alerted us to the Health Education Standards being proposed for all schools in the State of Nebraska. Here are some of the concerns of this program that the Nebraska Catholic Conference wants to bring to our attention:

- In 1st Grade, students “define gender, gender identity, and gender-role stereotypes.”
- In 4th Grade, students “distinguish between sex assigned at birth and gender identity and explain how they may or may not differ.”
- In 5th Grade, students “explain that gender expression and gender identity exist along a spectrum.”
- In 6th Grade, students “define and explain differences between cisgender, transgender, gender non-binary, gender expansive, and gender identity.
