Many priests, after a busy week leading up to Christmas with the assorted preparations required, take the days following Christmas off as an opportunity to recharge. So, this coming week I will be taking some more of my official vacation day: I plan to be around, but mostly catching up with family and friends. Of course, I'll respond to emergencies and any important needs that come up; but I plan for it to be a week with no classes, no meetings, no alarm clocks; more food, gatherings, music, and rest. To that end, you'll notice that all the daily Masses this coming week are scheduled for 12:15 pm, the time I have them on my day off.
