LENTEN REGULATIONS:

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence

All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence

Fasting limits eating to one full meal and two smaller meals/snacks. No snacking in between.

The fasting laws oblige all Catholics ages 18 through 59.

Abstinence requires abstaining from meat, meat-based products, and soups and gravies with a beef base. Abstinence obliges all Catholics over the age of 14.

Hard manual labor, pregnancy, and illness excuse individuals from these obligations.

ST. JAMES LENTEN ADULT ENRICHMENT SERIES: this Lent, on Thursday evenings at 7:00 pm. The topic is “The Seven Deadly Sins and the Seven Lively Virtues,” and consists of a video presentation by Bishop Robert Barron followed by a discussion period.
