PARISH AND FINANCE COMMITTEE:

The St. James community provides us with many opportunities to strengthen our faith and fellowship. These blessings have us looking to our future! As many of you know, our parish has experienced considerable growth over the years. In 1968, 42 families were registered in the parish. This grew to 70 in 2000, and since then has more than doubled to 180 in 2022!

We are seeing this growth not only in mass attendance, but also in participation in the CCD programs, with over 140 students registered. This leads to the issue of space. We have outgrown our parish hall, not only for the CCD program, but also for parish activities and events.

Our current church building was dedicated in 2001 with the hall added in 2003, for a total cost of \$1.4 million. With the generosity of parishioners, the debt associated with the construction was paid off within 20 years.

An addition to the hall will serve many purposes. To determine what is best suited for the parishioners of St. James, we need your input. This is your parish. Communication will include email surveys as well as in-person planning meetings to solicit feedback. We encourage you to participate in the in-person meetings, as discussion leads to more ideas. Ask yourself: What are the goals and needs of our parish in the next 5, 10, and 25 years? This information will then be collected and presented to the parish and used to develop action plans.

Please be on the lookout for communication regarding these surveys and meetings over the next months.
