ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY TO HEAVEN is a very important feast day celebrated as a solemnity w/ the Gloria & Creed. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (¶ 974) teaches, The Most Blessed Virgin Mary, when the course of her earthly life was completed, was taken up body & soul into the glory of heaven, where she already shares in the glory of her Son's Resurrection, anticipating the resurrection of all members of his Body. (Munificentissimus Deus the Apostolic Constitution of Pope Pius XII in 1950). Altho' normally a Holy Day of Obligation, the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary

falls on a Monday this year. When a holy day of oblig-ation, such as the *Mother of God* (Jan. 1), the *Assumption* (Aug. 15), or *All Saints* (Nov. 1), falls on a Saturday or Monday, the <u>obligation is waived</u> in some countries, including the <u>U.S.A.</u> as determined by each country's bishops who have that authority.
