We are very glad that you have joined us to do the public work of the People of God- to worship God. Ask if you need anything.

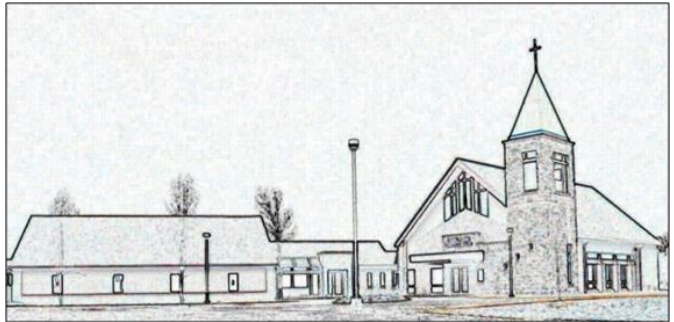
