OUR STONE SANCTUARY FLOOR is beautiful. It could be made more safe by adding a non-slip strip on the edges of all of the steps. I saw some at a church in Minnesota. It looked like a 1/2 or 3/4 inch strip of aggressive grit adhered to the stone step about 2 inches from the edge. It could also add contrast in color to indicate the edge.

<u>THE SACRED VESSELS AT ST. JAMES</u>- candlesticks, ciboria, chalices, patens, etc. **need cleaned & polished**. I was sacristan at both of my seminaries. Windex and lemon wax furniture polish do marvels on lacquered metal. Silver polish works on silver vessels that are not lacquered. Brass polish works on unlacquered brass. If you are interested in this kind of work speak to Fr. Lux.
