

EMERGENCY SUPPLIES: A		LENTEN REGULATIONS FOR THE LINCOLN DIOCESE:	ASH WEDNESDAY & GOOD FRIDAY are days of fast & abstinence. ALL FRIDAYS IN LENT are days of abstinence.					
	-	 FASTING means eating 1 full meal with two smaller meals, which together do not equal the full meal. No snacks or eating between meals allowed. Fasting obliges Catholics between the ages of 18 & 59. ABSTINENCE means eating no meat nor soup nor gravy made from meat. Abstinence obliges all Catholics over the age of 14. 	Sickness, hard manual labor, pregnancy, etc., automatically excuse a person from these obligations. Nevertheless, it should be pointed out that these are serious obligations. In cases of doubt or question, the priest who hears a person's confession should be consulted.
