





Meet our Mission Coop Priest.

My name is Fr. Justus Rwehumbiza Kahwa, a Catholic Priest ordained for Bukoba Catholic Diocese, Tanzania - East Africa. Presently I am serving as a teacher and formator at St. Augustine Major Seminary, Peramiho, which is one of the national major Seminaries in Tanzania. Meanwhile, I am doing a Licentiate (STL) program at the Sacred Heart Major Seminary in Detroit Archdiocese, USA. But I do my studies mainly online, but I usually come to the US in

summer for in person classes at the seminary. This will be my third time in the USA.

So, I have been asked by our Diocesan Mission Appeals Coordinator, Fr. Achilleus Rwegoshora, who is now serving in the USA, to participate in making those Appeals as I will be coming for my studies there. I am new to many places in the USA, and so I kindly ask your close cooperation in this, especially regarding accommodation and if possible making arrangements of how I get to the Parish. I will be very grateful!

I will be making the missionary appeals at St. James Church, Cortland on September 2nd and 3rd, 2023. I will probably be coming from St. Michael Church, Fairbury, because I am scheduled to be there for the weekend of 26 and 27 August....

DECLINE TO SIGN:

Recently passed LB753, the *Opportunity Scholarships Act*, helps to insure that our state's most vulnerable & financially challenged students have educational choices other than government schools. It has great potential to help students from St. James Parish who wish to have educational choice. However, within hours of the signing of that bill by the Governor, the powerful government school teacher's union, the NSEA, began a petition effort to repeal the law by referendum. The NSEA claims that the Opportunity Scholarship Act will "hurt" government schools, which is false.

Studies show that "school choice programs improve academic outcomes for not only the program participants, but also the students in public schools; save taxpayers money; & reduce racial segregation." Arguments against school choice have consistently been rooted in falsehood, deliberate misinformation or an attempt to smear non-public schools, such as Catholic schools.
