THAT MAN IS YOU (TMIY): We are starting the fall session of TMIY entitled "Worthy of the Call" on Saturday mornings at 6:30 AM in the parish hall. Despite the title men and woman are both invited. We watch a 45-minute video about how to practice your Catholic faith and then have 30 minutes of group discussion. **ALTAR BELLS** have been purchased for \$465 to have a set by the kneelers & another on the steps. Why new set of altar bells? The daily Mass server uses the kneeler. At Holy Thursday & Easter Vigil we can ring both during the Gloria!.
