May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

Visit a Cemetery between November 1 to November 8 & pray for the dead & gain a plenary indulgence applicable to a soul in purgatory. Tap into the superabundant merits of Jesus Life, death & resurrection.

A plenary indulgence is a grace granted by the Catholic Church through the merits of Jesus Christ, Mary and all the saints to remove the temporal punishment due to sin. The indulgence applies to sins already forgiven. A plenary indulgence cleanses the soul as if

the person had just been baptized.

Conditions: In order to obtain the plenary indulgence, in addition to performing the specific works mentioned above, the following conditions must be fulfilled: A plenary indulgence requires that the individual be in the state of grace by the completion of the acts, and have complete detachment from sin. The person must also sacramentally confess their sins and receive Communion, up to about 20 days before or after the indulgenced act. A single sacramental confession is sufficient for several plenary indulgences. For each plenary indulgence that is sought, however, a separate Holy Communion and a separate prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father are required. The prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father is left up to the choice of the individual.

No one but God knows for certain when a plenary indulgences is actually gained, because only he knows whether a person's dispositions are adequate. If these conditions are not satisfied, an otherwise plenary indulgence becomes only partial.
