



"YOU SHALL INDEED LOOK, BUT NEVER SEE..... (Is 6:9)

These foreboding words of God to Isaiah's people might be addressed to us. We go to Mass where we know and believe that the Holy Eucharist is truly the Body and Blood of Christ: and yet, as we sit in the pew, we become unmindful about that gift from God. Somehow, from Sunday to Sunday, it becomes more 'ordinary', and only a part of our Mass.

God gave us eyes to see in this material world, but He also gave us our 'minds eye', the ability to experience things we don't physically see. We look at Father raising the Host and saying, **"Behold the Lamb of God. Behold Him who takes away the sins of the world."** Look at the Host with your eyes, but see with the 'eye of your Soul'. 
