.....A PERSON, THE PERSON OF JESUS OF NAZARETH....

Quite early on, the name catechesis was given to the totality of the Church's efforts to make disciples, to **help people believe that Jesus is the son of God** so that in believing they might have life in His name, & to **educate & instruct them in this life, thus building up the Body of Christ.** -Prologue of the Catechism of the Catholic Church. (CCC no. 4)

At the heart of catechesis we find, in essence, a Person, the Person of Jesus of Nazareth, the only Son from the Father....who suffered & died for us & who now, after rising, is living with us forever. (CCC 426)

In order "to help people" -children, spouse, parents, friends- we must have **our own belief in the Son of God**, gathered through the

Gospel; the reasons for that belief; the experience of Christian living; the celebration of the Sacraments through the Church community; & a missionary witness with the zeal to bring others into the life of Jesus.

For the last several years, the St James Adult Enrichment Studies have offered the opportunity to understand & enlarge that belief in Jesus, so that it is not just "living with us forever", but **also living with those around us.** Simply put, **as we know & believe, so we can help others to know & believe** through what we have learned.
