### CHURCH BELLS ARE BEGINNING TO RING!

Six years ago, we were sitting on the veranda of a 13<sup>th</sup> century villa, in the mountains of Italy, high above the city of Florence. It was early Sunday morning, & we could see the vapor trails of fog, flowing for many miles across the countryside; the beauty of fine mist enhancing the fields of grapevines & olive trees on the distant hills.

From far away in the mountain valley, we began to hear Church bells, first from the east, & then from the west. And suddenly from directly behind us: gently pealing bells, calling people to Mass. We were called that morning, & went to Mass in the little village Church, a short walk behind our villa.

In Italy, it is the Catholic custom to ring the Church bells an

hour, a half hour, 15 minutes, & then 5 minutes before the time of Mass, creating a psychological effect to prepare the Faithful, materially & spiritually, for the coming celebration of the Holy Eucharist.

This year, Lent begins on February 14<sup>th</sup>, St. Valentine's Day, the day of love. Are you preparing during 'pre-Lent' how you can show your love for God, in this coming season of repentance & discipline? Are you planning your journey, involving self-reflection & self-giving; a journey intended to lift you spiritually, joyfully & expectantly through the 40 days of Lent?

*Ash Wednesday is almost here...  
 and the Church bells are beginning to ring!*


