Our good God has surrounded us with beauty that we experience through these senses; a red & gold sunset, the fragrance of a rose, the softness of a baby's cheek; & through these created things, if our hearts are open, we sometimes hear the faint whisper of God, & see Him in our mind's eye & in our soul; God, Who gives us all good things because He

loves us. ✦ *"Your invisible things are clearly seen from the creation of the world, being understood by the things that are made."* (St Augustine - Confessions) St. Paul tells us that *"He (Jesus) is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation."* (Col.1:15) Jesus, our Lord & God, came to earth to save us from our sins, & to reveal to us, in our human senses, the "invisible" God of Love become "the Word made flesh". & we begin to know that "Word" from His holy words in the Bible: that He ate, drank, slept, walked, was glad, was sad, preached...loved. We receive that "Word" during Mass in Holy Communion. ✦ So as you pray, or 'see' Him in Adoration, be aware that even though our love for Him may be inconstant at times, His Love is with us, & for us, forever in this life, & when we see Him, face to face, in Heaven. *Love in the Spirit. 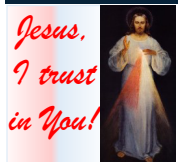

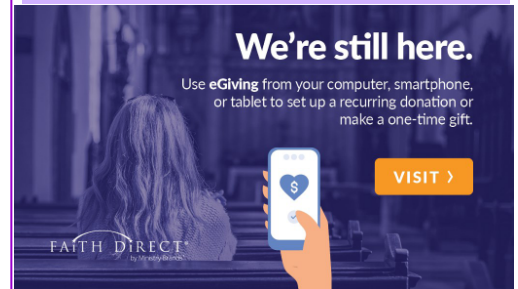

Lenten Regulations for the Diocese of Lincoln for 2024

- Ash Wednesday & Good Friday** are days of fast & abstinence. All **Fridays in Lent** are days of abstinence.
 - Fasting** means eating only one full meal with two smaller meals, which together do not equal the full meal. No snacking or eating between meals is allowed. Fasting obliges all Catholics **between the ages of 18 & 59**.
Abstinence means eating no meat, & no soup or gravy made from meat. Abstinence obliges all Catholics **over the age of 14**.
Sickness, hard manual labor, pregnancy, etc. automatically excuse a person from these obligations. Nevertheless, it should be pointed out that these are serious obligations.
In cases of **doubt or question**, the priest who hears a person's confession should be consulted.
- Easter Vigil** is on **Holy Saturday, March 30, 2024**. The Vigil Mass must begin after sunset. This year it can be as early as 8 pm.
 - NB: The Solemnity of the Annunciation** of the Lord is transferred from 3/25 to April 8, 2024 as if falls during Holy Week this year.
