**Lenten Regulations for the Diocese of Lincoln for 2024**

1. **Ash Wednesday & Good Friday** are days of fast & abstinence. **All Fridays in Lent** are days of abstinence.
  2. **Fasting** means eating only one full meal with two smaller meals, which together do not equal the full meal. No snacking or eating between meals is allowed. Fasting obliges all Catholics **between the ages of 18 & 59**. **Abstinence** means eating no meat, & no soup or gravy made from meat. Abstinence obliges all Catholics **over the age of 14**. **Sickness, hard manual labor, pregnancy, etc.** automatically excuse a person from these obligations. Nevertheless, it should be pointed out that these are serious obligations. In cases of **doubt or question**, the priest who hears a person's confession should be consulted.
- **Easter Vigil** is on **Holy Saturday, March 30, 2024**. The *Vigil Mass* must begin after sunset. This year is can be **as early as 8 pm**.
  - NB: The *Sol. of the Annunciation* is transferred from 3/25 to **April 8**, as if falls during Holy Week this year.

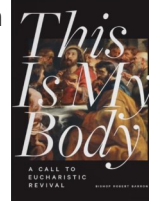

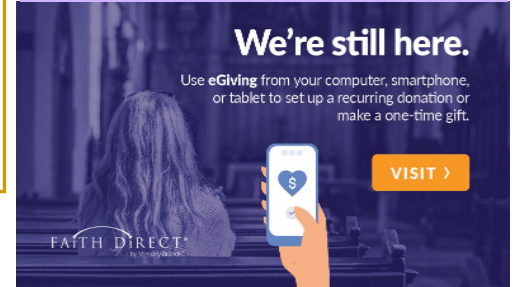
