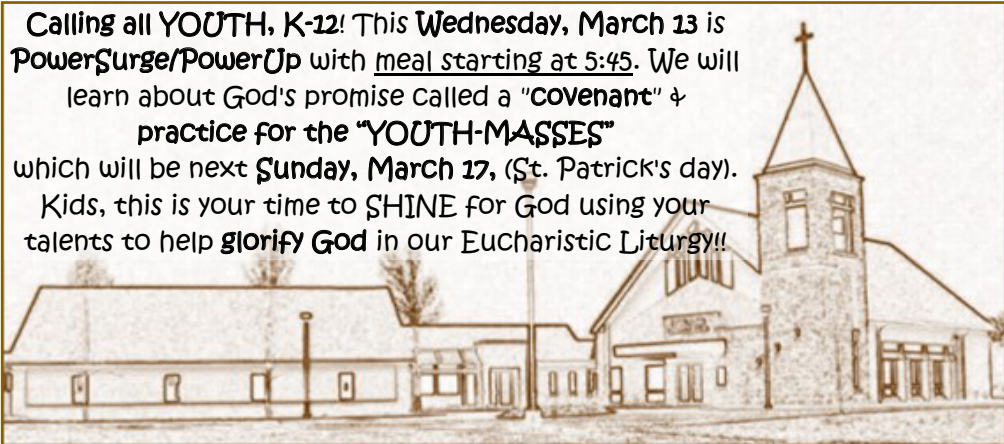

DEAR FRIENDS AT ST. JAMES...

Hopefully you've heard about the **Seder Supper** celebration planned for **Palm Sunday** evening, reviving a **St. James Parish** tradition in conjunction with the **Eucharistic Revival**. The meal recalls the **Passover** when the Hebrews escaped Egyptian slavery, (cf. the Book of *Exodus*), & the **Jesus' Last Supper**, & **Passover** from death to life recounted in the Gospels.

When you come to this supper you can enjoy the **special foods** that were part of the original Passover meal in the Bible, & **participate in the ceremonial** part of the supper, using **Hebrew prayers & blessings** from the night of the *Exodus*. You & your **family**, can experience the prophetic connection be-

tween the Passover of the *Old Testament*, & the **First Mass & Holy Eucharist** of the *New Testament*, celebrated at Jesus' Last Passover meal in Jerusalem with His Apostles.

The **Seder Supper** will be held on **Palm Sunday, March 24**, at **6 pm** in the **Parish Hall**. A **sign-up sheet** is on the **table** by the **front door** of the **Church**. Please **bring a pot-luck dish** to share. **Meat & bread** will be provided. You may **sign up to donate some of the special Passover foods** listed on the sheet.

This celebration is **intended for the whole family** to enjoy, & will give all of us a **good beginning to Holy Week** with our fellow parishioners.

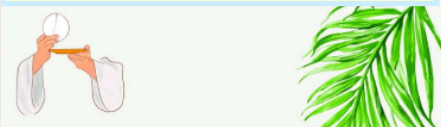

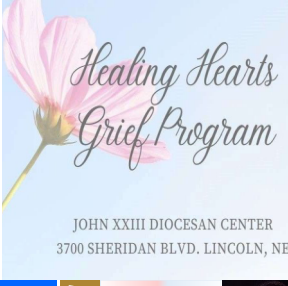
