...SENDING DOWN YOUR SPIRIT UPON THEM...

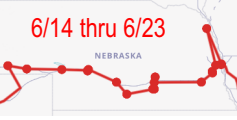
In our everyday world, we usually need a clear understanding of something before accepting & believing it, especially if it is important to us. In our Faith world, this becomes of prime importance, & so, concerning our belief in the Pascal mystery of the Mass, we may ask this question: exactly what, or who, is it that transforms the bread & wine into the Body & Blood of Christ?

"The EPICLESIS (invocation upon) is the intercession in which the priest begs the **Father** to send the, **Holy Spirit**, the Sanctifier, so that the offerings may become the body & blood of **Christ**, & that the faithful, by receiving them, may themselves become a living offering to God." In the Epiclesis, "there is an outpouring of the **Holy Spirit** that makes the unique mystery present." (CCC 1104-1105)

In the mystery of the Mass, the priest "begs": "**O Lord, Make holy therefore, these gifts, we pray, by sending down your Spirit upon them like the dewfall, so that they may become for us the Body & Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ.**"

With the sacrificial offering of Jesus' Body & Blood, we also become a "living offering" by receiving the Holy Eucharist; & we are enabled to participate in this life-giving Sacrament of God through the loving action of the **Holy Trinity: God the Father sends the Holy Spirit to sanctify the bread & wine, which becomes the Body & Blood, Soul & Divinity of Jesus.** O Lord, we thank You & we praise You. *Love in the Spirit. -Diana M. Eucharistic Revival Parish Point Person*
