I think it was given to us by a priest years ago when parishes were moving the altars forward, & 'modernizing' the interiors of Churches.

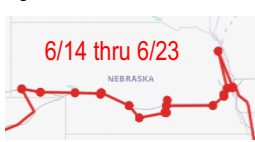

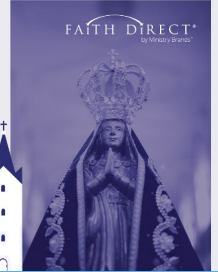
