**...THE LABORERS ARE FEW....**In the TV show, **The Chosen**, a scene depicted 2 apostles washing clothes on the bank of the Sea of Galilee. Their conversation was about the necessity of having clean clothes compared to spreading the words of Jesus. Was it more important to spend their time teaching people about the Messiah, rather than the common job of washing clothes for the apostles?

In **St James Church** last Saturday morning, some men carried all the heavy oak furniture back to the altar, that had been removed for the work on the ceiling. Several of those men regularly assisted Father at Mass in the form of Acolytes and Lectors. Was it more important that these men should focus their energies and talents for Father during Mass, than in doing the heavy lifting of moving furniture?

*"The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few, so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest."* (Matt 9:37)

Our priest, Father Lux, is God's Laborer for us, but did Jesus intend that this calling go beyond 'harvesting souls' for God? Could it also include working for those already harvested, the people of God? I think of all those parishioners who do God's work for the faithful of **St. James**: decorating the altar, mowing the lawns, upkeep of the Church building, preparing food for Matt Talbot or parish dinners, gardening around the Church, providing the music, teaching the children, helping the home-bound, moving furniture, supporting pro-life, adult Bible study, **Knights of Columbus**, **PCCW**, Acolytes. Lectors, greeters, ushers, & many more, including those whose mission is to pray for the Church, & those 'laboring' to bring Jesus Christ into all lives.
