We are told in 1 Kings 19:11-12, how God came to Elijah as he stood on the mountain waiting for the Lord. *There was a strong & violent wind rending the mountains & crushing rocks before the Lord—but the Lord was not in the wind,...an earthquake—but the Lord was not in the earthquake; after the earthquake, ...fire—but the Lord was not in the fire; after the fire,...A LIGHT, SILENT SOUND.*
