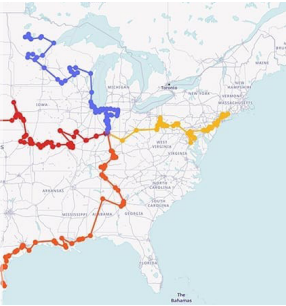

**.....BEST LAID PLANS.....**

Last week my sister was taken to the ER, unable to walk. She has been living alone, & taking care of herself for the last 7 years, but has residual effects from cancer years ago, including numbness in her feet. After 5 days in the hospital under observational care, it was determined, that with physical therapy, she would be able to walk again with a walker, but would have to go into an assisted living facility. As her sister, I have chosen to take on the responsibility of planing & arranging for her move into her new assisted living apartment.

Unfortunately this must all take place during the month of July, the month of the *National Eucharistic Congress* meeting in Indianapolis. As Point Person from St. James, I & my husband had registered to go on the bus trip with others from our Diocese to participate in this Revival experience, & now we cannot go. The old Robert Burns' saying, "the best laid plans of mice & men often go awry", comes to mind. But turning to *Isaiah 55: 8-9*, the Bible says it best, *For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways....for as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, My thought higher than your thoughts.*

So, Catholic Friends, when we choose to live God's words in our everyday life, we believe these words, that no matter how important our plans are to us, our ways are not always God's ways. **Then we commit ourselves with joy, to whatever happens, & to accept God's ways in our earthly life, in order to live forever with God in our Eternal life.**

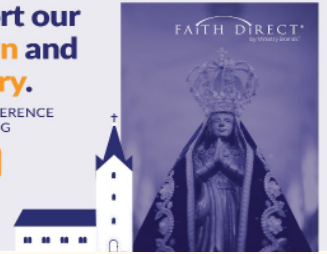
