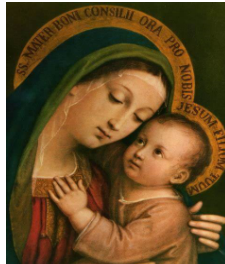

.....A COMMUNION OF LOVE.....

In continuing the reflection on Isaiah 55:8-9 from last week, I will try to explain my reaction in having to cancel our trip to Indianapolis, and the 'gift' of the trip to someone else. This quote from *The Imitation of Christ* by Thomas a Kempis may help: "For the resolutions of the just depend rather on the grace of God than on their own wisdom; and in Him they always put their trust, whatever they take in hand. For man proposes, but God disposes, neither is the way of man in his own hands." (Bk 1:19)


What is "the grace of God"? According to the Catholic Catechism, "It is participation in the life of God," a sharing in the divine nature of God, leading us to Eternal life with Him... "a stable and supernatural disposition that perfects the soul itself to enable it to live with God, to act by His love... in a **Communion of Love** as we collaborate (with the Holy Spirit) in the salvation of others and in the growth of the Body of Christ, the Church." (#1997 - 2003) Simply put, we receive His grace, and we 're-gift' it to others through our good works.

We thank our loving Father for this gift of His grace in our lives, and then we "give" this grace to others. Bishop Robert Barron calls this the "loop of grace", "God offers as a sheer grace, the gift of being (God's creation), but if we try to cling to that gift and make it our own, we lose it... God's grace, precisely because it is grace, cannot be held on to; rather it is had only in the measure that it remains grace—that is to say, a gift given away. One realizes this truth when one enters willingly into the loop of grace, giving away that which one is receiving." (Eucharist - Barron)

I have come to realize that, by **accepting the will of God** over my will, I didn't lose the grace I would have received by attending the Eucharistic Congress, I gave away the trip, and the grace, to some else at St James who will attend instead of me.

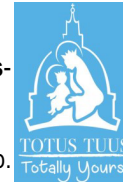

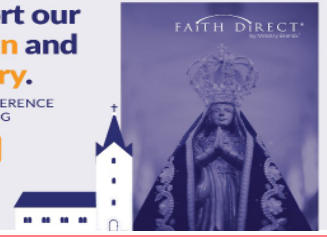
