....THE PIERCING OF THE SACRED HEART

July is dedicated to the **precious Blood of Christ**. At the celebration of the Mass, also called the Holy Eucharist, we profess the Body and Blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ. After the Consecration, His Body is present on the paten, and His Blood in the chalice. In the Life of Christ by Bishop Fulton J. Sheen, there is a description of the 7 "distinct blood sheddings of Christ: the Circumcision, the Agony in the Garden, the Scourging, the Crowning of Thorns, the Way of the Cross, the Crucifixion, and the Piercing of the Sacred Heart".

One of the soldiers stabbed His side with a lance, and at once there was a flow of blood and water." (John 19:13)

In Bishop Sheen's words, "...a few precious drops of His Blood (poured) forth after He gave up His spirit, to show that His love was stronger than death, their archives of recordings for those dates at spiritcatholicra-Blood and water came forth; Blood, the price of Redemption and the symbol of the Eucharist; water, the symbol of regeneration and baptism. St John, who witnessed the scene of the soldier piercing the Heart of Christ, wrote about it later:

This is He who came with water and blood: Jesus Christ. He came, not by water alone, but by water and blood. (1 John 5:6)

"...John gave (this) a mysterious and sacramental significance. Water stood at the beginning of Our Lord's ministry when He was baptized, Blood stood at the close of it when He offered Himself as a spotless oblation. Both became the ground of faith, for at the baptism, the Father declared Him to be Hs Son, and the Resurrection witnessed again to His Divinity." (The Life of Christ, p.398)

As the water and the wine are **mixed in the Chalice by the priest**, we relive that final "shedding" of Christ's precious Blood, and we see our salvation to come, when we worthily receive the Holy Eucharist.


