senses, then, from the spiritual insight gained from the senses & the stirring of emotions, to raise the human world to God, to His inexpressible kingdom of mystery, beauty & life." (National Directory for Catechesis, p. 148)

If so, had they been in response to our prayers, filling & inundating our hearts & souls, & used by God's will to heal & save? Did we witness the "power of prayer"? Only God knows!

When anyone enters your home, they'll know you are Catholic by the "sacred art" you devoutly display, in every season of the year. The hymn, **They'll Know We are Christians by Our Love**, is the inspiration for these thoughts; hopefully provoking you to sing this response from verse 4:
