The Catholic Christmas season starts on the Nativity, December 25, 2024, & ends on January 5, 2025, the Sunday Mass celebration of the Epiphany.

The Octave of Christmas includes the eight days between Christmas Day & January 1, which is both the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God, & New Year's Day.

What are the 12 Days of Ch<mark>ristmas, & where did they come from?</mark>


The 12 Days of Christmas are the 12 days between Christmas Day & Epiphany. The "12 Days" likely had pre-Christian roots, though the term was likely adapted to fit the Church calendar in celebration of the Nativity. Tradition also holds that the Three Kings' journey to meet the baby Jesus was twelve days.

#### What is Epiphany?

Epiphany is the celebration of the revelation of Jesus as the Son of God – here on earth with us. The feast is also known as "Three Kings Day," the day the Magi visited Jesus in Bethlehem.
