...BECOME CHILDREN OF THE LIGHT...

Did you ever wonder why God chose to send His Son to us to become a man, & live & die like us, & so save us? He could have just 'thought' us saved, & it would have happened; no need for God to become a human to save His children for Himself. What does sending His Son tell us about God's plan for us?

We know that God our Father is entirely spiritual, not physical as we are. We do not experience Him with our five senses, unless He appears as a material object such as a burning bush or a dove, described in the Bible. God shows His love for us in creating the beauty of our physical world, but beyond that, He puts into our souls the desire to return to Him; we are lovingly conformed to Him spiritually, at a deeper level than our senses.

Even so, ungratefully, we often turn away from Him, as the temptations of our 'real' world entice us & pull us into sin. In God's omniscience He knew that humans, in their physical world, reacted with great fear, but were susceptible, to powers that were beyond them unto death; and, in love, He sent His Son to become a man, to die as a man, to redeem us from sin & bring us to Himself. "Now since the children share

in blood & flesh, He likewise shared in them, that through death He might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is the devil, & free those who through fear of death had been subject to slavery all their life." (Heb 2:14-15)

With God on earth in "blood & flesh", humans, with all their five senses, were able to see & experience God as a man like them. In their desire for God they were given the opportunity to also spiritually recognize their Creator in this man, Jesus; but because of the free will granted them by God, they could choose to reject Him or accept Him. Large crowds accepted Him as He worked miracles & fed them, however, once He required belief in His words about His Body & Blood, & about His claim to be the Son of God, many left Him.

Even today, in God's plan for us, we are given that choice to reject Him, "You belong to this world, but I do not belong to this world. That is why I told you that you will die in your sins. For if you do not believe that I AM, you will die in your sins." (Jn 8:23-24), or to follow Him & "become children of the Light....Whoever follows Me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." (8:12)
