...DID YOU TRY?...

Recently I was going through some old papers that I found in cleaning out my filing cabinet. Opening one folded page, this excerpt from an old speech by Representative Henry Hyde caught my interest.

When the time comes as it surely will, when we face that awesome moment, the final judgment, I've often thought, as (Bishop) Fulton Sheen wrote, that it is a terrible moment of loneliness. You have no advocates, you are there alone standing before God and a terror will rip through your soul like nothing you can imagine. But I really think that those in the pro-life movement will not be alone. I think there will be a chorus of voices that have never been heard in this world but are heard beautifully and clearly in the next world and they will plead for everyone who has been in this movement. They will say to God "Spare him because he loved us," and God will look at you and say not, "Did you succeed?" but "Did you try?"

Henry Hyde was a legendary 'lion' for the pro-life movement, highly esteemed for courageously introducing the Hyde Amend-

ment, and successfully working for its passage. This Amendment prohibits federal funds from being used for abortion in most cases, and has saved at least 2.5 million lives since it was passed in Congress in 1976. As a member of the House of Representatives, he used his unique power and position, because of his love of God and neighbor, to save the lives of so many of God's innocent, pre-born children.

So, as we watch our newly elected Senators and Representatives in our nation's capitol, may our expectations and prayers support them as they "try" to fulfill their duty toward God and their country by the passage of just and moral laws; and that they will emulate the example of Henry Hyde to take up and hold positions, at times contrary to public opinion, but in faithfulness with God's plan for the common good. May they respond along with the prophet Isaiah:

Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, **"Whom shall I send/ Who will go for us?"**

"Here I am," I said, "Send me!" (Is 6:8)
