

Where Faith Meets Fun

...WHOEVER HAS SEEN ME...

Yesterday afternoon, I was sitting under the willow tree, on our rock patio, with our dog Alana, My husband, Corky, came out of the garage wearing a welding helmet which covered his face and head. Of course it made him look like Darth Vader of Starwars. The dog took one look at him, leaped up into the air, and ran away, barking like crazy. Evidently she thought he was a stranger, even though she and Corky are best friends. As soon as he took the helmet off, she saw his face, and immediately came to him, wagging her tail. All she needed was to see the face she was accustomed to.

After the excitement wore down, I remembered a time many years ago, when our daughter was 7 months old. I had put curlers in my hair, and went to get her up from her nap. She looked at me with a smile on her face, which quickly turned to a tearful pout and frightened crying. She was afraid of me because my face looked different with no hair around it.

In our daily routines, we also find this problem in our cell phones. For many of us, facial recognition is what opens our phones. I was surprised to find that when I put on different glasses to use the computer, the AI on my phone did not recognize me and would not log me on. How strange is the world we live in!

The familiarity of the face of someone we see daily, creates comfort and belonging for us, as it was for the Apostles when they saw Jesus everyday. The twelve Apostles lived with Jesus for 3 years, traveling through Galilee and other provinces, watching Him teach and heal; the closeness of eating, drinking, and daily life allowed them to see Him in every situation, to see His face in every

expression, and in every light; but when Peter and the others saw him on the seashore after the Resurrection, they did not know it was He. His resurrected face had changed. "So they went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing. When it was already dawn, Jesus was standing on the shore; but the disciples did not realize that it was Jesus." (Jn 21:3-4) They had become so accustomed to seeing that human face that they didn't know the glorified face of God in the flesh. A similar experience happened to two men when they met Jesus on the way to Emmaus. They didn't recognize Him.

In reading the Gospel of John (14:8-9), we can sense the disappointment that Jesus felt at the inability of His Apostles to comprehend the Truth before them. "Jesus said, "If you know me, then you will also know my Father. From now on you do know him and have seen him." Philip said to him "Master, show us the Father, and that will be enough for us." Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you for so long a time and you still do not know me, Philip? **Whoever has seen me, has seen the Father.**"

It took a simple request from Philip, for Jesus to reveal the immortal face of His Godhead, that He is the Incarnation of the Holy Trinity.

When I look at a picture of the Shroud of Turin, and see the image of the marred and tortured face of Jesus, I try to recreate His human face in my mind, hoping to see the face of my God. We should have Faith and Hope that we shall see Jesus face to face in Heaven, as the answer to our soul's longing for God.


