The month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood. The feast of the Precious Blood of our Lord was instituted in 1849 by Pius IX, but the devotion is as old as Christianity. The early Fathers say that the Church was born from the pierced side of Christ, & that the sacraments were brought forth through His Blood.

"The Precious Blood which we worship is the Blood which the Savior shed for us on Calvary & reassumed at His glorious Resurrection; it is the Blood which courses through the veins of His risen, glorified, living body at the right hand of God the Father in heaven; it is the Blood made present on our altars by the words of Consecration; it is the Blood which merited sanctifying grace for us & through it washes & beautifies our soul & inaugurates the beginning of eternal life in it."

St James the Greater is our parish titular saint. His feast day is THIS Friday, July 25. The following is from the 1910 Catholic Encyclopedia on http://www.newadvent.org/cathen/08279b.htm The son of Zebedee & Salome (Cf. Mt 27:56; Mk 15:40; 16:1). Zahn asserts that Salome was the daughter of a priest. James is styled "the Greater" to distinguish him from the Apostle James "the Less", who was probably shorter of stature. We know nothing of St. James's early life. He was the brother of John, the beloved disciple, & probably the elder of the two. His parents seem to have been people of means as appears from the following facts. • Zebedee was a fisherman of the Lake of Galilee, who prob. lived in or near Bethsaida (Jn 1:44), perhaps in Capharnaum; & had some boatmen or hired men as his usual attendants (Mk 1:20). • Salome was one of the pious women who afterwards followed Christ & "ministered unto him of their substance" (cf. Mt 27:55, sq.; Mk 15:40; 16:1; Lk 8:2 sq.; 23:55-24:1). • St. John was personally known to the high-priest (Jn 18:16); & must have had wherewithal to provide for the Mother of Jesus (John 19:27). It is probable, according to Acts 4:13, that John (& consequently his brother James) had not received the technical training of the rabbinical schools; in this sense they were unlearned & without any official position among the Jews. But, according to the social rank of their parents, they must have been men of ordinary education, in the common walks of Jewish life. They had frequent opportunity of coming in contact with Greek life & language, which were already widely spread along the shores of the Galilean Sea. (See more on the flier inserted.)
