
Prayer for the Dignity of Work and the Rights of Workers

However, if you are **unable to attend in person** due to serious reasons such as illness or duty, you are excused from the Sunday obligation & watching Mass online can provide spiritual benefits.

Those who are **shut-in** should contact their local parish to have someone bring them **Communion**.
